



## ASU Recognized Field Holidays

Below is an outline of the **ASU Holiday Schedule for Calendar Year 2021**, as well as our policy regarding recognized holidays for Field Education. The dates listed below are the only holidays that field students are allowed to take as credit, as long as the assigned agency also recognizes the same holidays. Spring Break does not count as an ASU recognized holiday. Students must obtain approval from their Field Instructors prior to changing their schedule.

As defined in our **Field Education Policies - Policy Number SWK 710-05**:

**PURPOSE:** To define policy for holidays

**SOURCES:** Field Education Policies

**APPLICABILITY:** All students in Field Education

**POLICY:** Holidays

Students receive credit for regularly scheduled internship hours on days observed and recognized as holidays by both the agency and the School. Students may observe other religious holidays, but these are treated as absences to be made up. Students are required to make up the internship hours from any other holiday that is observed by the agency that occur on Field days.

Fall and Spring Break are not considered a holiday. If students want to take these breaks, they must seek prior approval from the Field Instructor and have an approved plan for completing the rescheduled internship hours.
