Gabe Zimmerman Memorial Scholarships are awarded to MSW students who have demonstrated a dedication to the areas of either public behavioral health or policy, and who have shown a commitment to the values of service and social justice that Gabe demonstrated in his personal and professional life.

In order to be eligible for this award, applicants must be enrolled in the MSW program at the ASU School of Social Work, Tucson, and must be entering into their concentration year of coursework. Students also must be making good progress in the MSW program and have a GPA of at least 3.5.

**Application requirements**

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled in the MSW program at the School of Social Work, Tucson, be entering into their concentration year of coursework and have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
2. Submission of completed application form.
3. Submission of essay (three typed, double-space pages). Essay must address career and educational goals, professional interests and work/volunteer experience as they related to one or both of the following areas of interest: public behavioral health and/or policy. Applicants may also discuss any financial hardship and ways in which this scholarship will help them achieve their professional goals.
4. Submission of a professional resume.
