



## Latino Cultural Competency in Social Work Graduate Certificate Program

The Latino Cultural Competency certificate program is designed for Spanish Speaking MSW students and Spanish-Speaking professionals who want to:

- Deliver culturally and linguistically appropriate social services to Latino clients
- Understand the complexities and diversity of the Latino client population;
- Understand the critical cross-cultural factors that influence a worker's competency in forming professional helping relationship with Latino clients and their families.
- Identify social justice issues involved in providing services for limited English-speaking and non-English speaking Latino population.
- Enhance their employment potential by adding an expertise in social services for Latino clients

The Certificate is 15-credit certificate program within the existing ASU master's social work degree program, as well as a stand-alone 15-credit certificate for community professionals. The certificate program consists of a combination of Latino/Diversity oriented coursework and a bilingual/bicultural practicum with Spanish speaking clients, families and communities.

## Admission Criteria

- I. Academic Degree Status in one of the following
- Current enrollment in the ASU Downtown Master of Social of Work Program and a GPA of 3.0; or
- Hold a Master of Social Work or related masters degree with a GPA of 3.0 or Bachelor of Social Work (with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for junior and senior semesters); or
- A bachelor's degree in a related field (with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for junior and senior semesters of the bachelor's degree) and the equivalency of a <u>two-year full-time</u> human service/social service experience.
  - II Successfully pass the Spanish language proficiency exam

Acceptance into to the certificate program is contingent on an applicant's successful completion of the Spanish language proficiency examination administered through the ASU School of Social Work. .
