Undergraduate Student Qualifications (BSW):

- ✦ Completed 9 semester hours of required ASU social work courses.
- ✦ Achieve and maintain a minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.50.

Graduate Student Qualifications (MSW):

- ✦ Completed one semester of coursework with a minimum of 9 semester hours of ASU social work courses.
- ✦ Achieve and maintain a minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.75.

History of Phi Alpha

Phi Alpha was established in 1962. The purposes of the Honor Society, as stated in its brochure, are to “provide a closer bond among students of social work and promote humanitarian goals and ideals.” Further, Phi Alpha “fosters high standards of education for social workers and invites into membership those who have attained excellence in scholarship and achievement in social work.” At present, there are over 243 chapters of the Honor Society in schools around the country, including the established chapter at ASU.
